- ALPINE RULES TO REMEMBER**
1. All racers should inspect the course prior to race
 2. No free skiing on the race course
 3. Ski slow or side slip down to the start area
 4. All reruns will be allowed once the racer arrives back at the start
 5. You are disqualified if you lose a ski on course, except for the last four gates
 6. You are disqualified if you miss one or more gates
 7. If a gate is missing—ski off the course immediately and do not go through the finish. See an official at the finish area to confirm you get a rerun
 8. The most important rule of all—Have Fun!!!

 - o Snowboard Race - Separate Race Course with Stubby Gates
 - o Telemark Racers share course with Novice Racers
 - o Dual Courses will be handicapped to calculate winners
- **Showcase Fun Race** (Dual GS Open to All Ability Levels and Disciplines)
 - o Individual & Team competition (Teams Randomly Created)
- **Freestyle Competition** (Ski, Snowboard or Whatever You Ride)
 - o Subjectively judged
- **Uphill Challenge** (Walk Uphill Next To Race Course)
 - o Free equipment provided
 - o Timed walk uphill with stopwatch
- **Vertical Challenge** (Log Runs Sunday through Thursday on www.nbs.org)
 - o Most vertical feet in 5 days
 - o Use GPS in phone application (ie Ski Tracks, Map Your Ride, Fitbit)
- **Nordic & Snowshoe Competition**
 - o Log Treks Sunday through Thursday on www.nbs.org
 - o Pick own course anywhere at anytime. Longest distance wins.
 - o Use GPS in phone application (ie Ski Tracks, Map Your Ride, Fitbit)
- **Scavenger Hunt** (Submit Answers Sunday through Thursday on www.nbs.org)
 - o Explore the Mountain to Answer Clues (Green & Blue Runs Only)
